Message of the Week

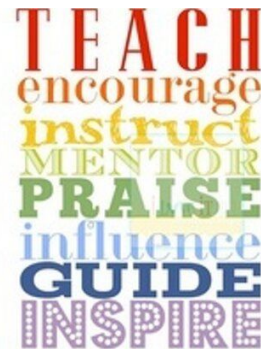
