WHAT CAN THE ZONE OFFER YOUR STUDENT?

Academic Coaching and Counseling

- ✓ Direct support from full-time Zone Facilitators providing mentoring, counseling, homework help and academic advocacy
- ✓ One-on-one and group tutoring, a component that engages more than 250 tutors from local colleges and universities
- ✓ Access to academic and technology resources in the Zone

College Readiness Initiative

- ✓ Free year-long SAT prep course
- ✓ Postsecondary guidance and support through:
 - ★ College workshops on financial aid, application tips, etc.
 - ★ College athlete recruitment support
 - ★ Annual college fair (attended by more than 600 people this Fall at Madison Park), and college campus visits

Intramural Sports

- ✓ Intramural leagues, coached by Scholar Athletes staff, targeting non-varsity, ineligible or off-season athletes are mandated by Zone attendance and academic standards to increase academic performance.
- ✓ Launched in 2013, the Boston Scholar Athletes intramural program currently engages more than 1,000 students in dozens of sports

Athletic and Academic Recognition

- ✓ Four-year college scholarship program, in partnership with eight local colleges and universities, providing more than \$1.4M in aid to eligible Zone members since 2013
- ✓ Athletic camp scholarships (last year, more than 150 students attended high recognized summer athletic camps)
- ✓ All-BSA Team, Scholar-Athlete of the Month, and Most Valuable Scholar-Athlete awards
